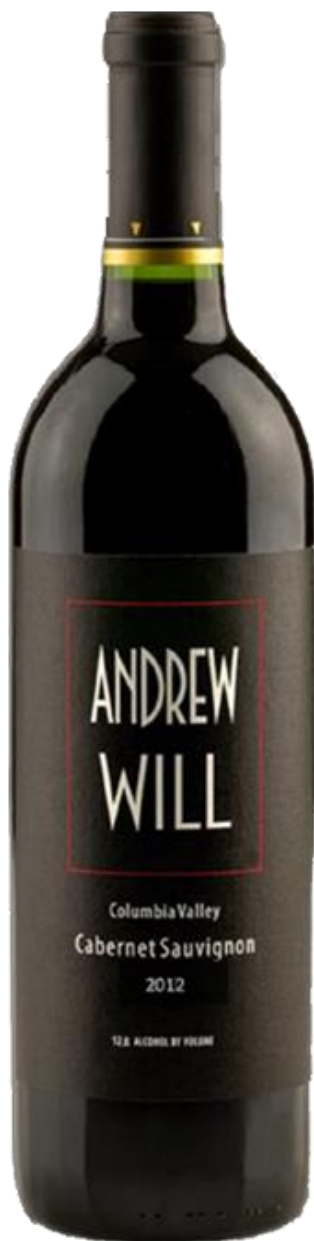


# 2012 Columbia Valley Cabernet Sauvignon



The fruit for this wine is from our own Two Blondes vineyard. We use three clones of Cabernet Sauvignon at the vineyard, which are included in this wine. Chris Camarda is a proponent of clonal variety and we have French, Washington and California Cabernet Sauvignon clones planted.

The wine spent 12 months in 35% new French oak and is very lightly sulphured. The 2012 vintage marked a return to more historical averages in terms of temperature after two successive cool vintages in 2010 and 2011. A notable aspect to the growing season was a 100-day spell with no measurable precipitation from July through mid-October.

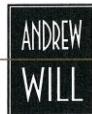
