

## 2013 SORELLA



The 2013 Sorella displays a lush and scented nose that offers a wide range of both dark and red fruits combined with undertones of cooking spices, minerals and floral notes. This red blend is composed of 78% Cabernet Sauvignon, 10% Merlot, 6% Cabernet Franc and 6% of co-fermented Petite Verdot and Malbec.

This full-bodied wine combines smooth, plush tannins with an acidity that creates a superb overall balance in the mid-palate. The finish is a wonderfully drawn out experience that adds to the complexity of this spectacular wine.

*Sorella* means sister in Italian and the wine was named to honor Chris Camarda's late sister when it was first produced in 1994. The portrait on the label now is Chris' late wife Annie who died in 2005.
